BOARD COMMITTEES

0155 BOARD COMMITTEES

The Board of Education authorizes the creation of committees of Board members charged to conduct studies, make recommendations to the Board, and act in an advisory capacity. Committees are not authorized to take action on behalf of the Board.

1. The business of the Board of Education other than negotiations shall be conducted at the meeting of the Board acting as a Committee of the Whole, unless the Board President or presiding officer directs a committee of Board members to meet separately to engage in further study or consideration of the matter within its purview before further consideration by the Committee of the Whole.

The Regular monthly meeting of the Board of Education will be the Committee of the Whole meeting.

These bylaws are not to be construed as to require meetings on different days for the Committee of the Whole and the Board meeting in work session.

2. To facilitate communication between Board members and administration/staff on various aspects of district operations, there will be a Board representative on the following district committees/councils:

- a. Affirmative Action/Equity Council
- b. Curriculum Revision Council
- c. Staff Development Council
- d. School/Community Relations Council
- e. Technology

Annually, following the reorganization meeting, the assignments will be made by the Board President after consultation with each Board member.

3. School/Community Relations business shall be conducted at a meeting of the Board acting as the Committee of the Whole. Such meetings shall be held on different dates than those scheduled for conducting all other business of the Committee of the Whole.

BOARD COMMITTEES

4. The Board of Education will have one standing committee which is to be reaffirmed each year or terminated as the Board may choose at the annual reorganization meeting. The current committee is:

Negotiations

The committee appointments will be made by the Board President after consultation with each Board member.

5. The Board President may appoint special committees consisting only of Board members, as the need arises, to deal with specific issues before the Board.

6. Ad Hoc Advisory Committee - are covered under Policy 9140. All sub-committees are working advisory committees.

The Board reserves the right to meet and work as a Committee of the Whole in informational, discussion, and exploratory sessions. No official action shall be taken at these meetings, unless so advertised.
