PUPIL USE OF VEHICLES

5514 PUPIL USE OF VEHICLES

The Board of Education regards the operation by pupils of any vehicle for transportation to and from school as a matter subject to Board authority because pupil safety is of paramount concern to the Board.

The Board will permit the use of motor vehicles by pupils age seventeen and older in accordance with district rules provided that such pupils present written parental approval, have been granted permission by the Building Principal to operate a motor vehicle on school grounds, possess a New Jersey driver's license, and have successfully completed a course in driver education.

The Board prohibits the operation of scooters and skateboards by pupils for travel to and from school.

The Board will permit the use of bicycles, starting in grade three, in accordance with district rules provided such pupils present written parental approval, have been granted permission by the Building Principal.

The Superintendent shall develop and disseminate regulations for the operation and parking of vehicles on school grounds. Permission to operate a vehicle on school grounds may be revoked for a pupil's failure to observe rules.

The Board will not be responsible for any vehicle that is lost, stolen, or damaged.
