5843 BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL CARE PROGRAM

The Board of Education recognizes the needs of children who may lack adult supervision outside the school day and directs the Superintendent to establish and implement an optional Before and After School Care Program (hereafter referred to as Kidcare) for the care of such children in grades kindergarten through five.

The Board will provide suitable district facilities for the conduct of Kidcare at 7:00 a.m. to the beginning of the school day for grades kindergarten through five; and at the close of each school day to 6:00 p.m. for pupils in grades kindergarten through five.

Kidcare is an optional, fee-based program that is provided as a service to the parents/guardians of K-5 students. Tuition is paid by parents/guardians directly to the school district. Tuition rates are established by the Board of Education.

The program will be under the direct supervision of a coordinator employed by the district, who may be assisted by aides. Kidcare provides children with a supervised environment that includes time for rest, play, homework and socialization.

Kidcare is open to any K-5 district child, provided the program can meet the needs of that child.

Kidcare reserves the right to determine if the program can meet such needs. Students whose behavior is deemed unacceptable will be removed from the program.
