### Fiscal Management

The Board of Education recognizes that money and management are a necessary support of the whole school program. To make that support as effective as possible, the Board intends:

1. To encourage advance planning through the best possible budget procedures;
2. To explore all practical sources of dollar income;
3. To guide the expenditure of funds so as to produce the greatest educational returns;
4. To expect top quality accounting and reporting procedures; to adopt and implement sound fiscal procedures; and
5. To maintain a level of per pupil expenditure sufficient to provide high quality education.

### Support Services

The Board of Education expects high standards of safety in the operation and maintenance of the school plant and equipment. In order to maintain the health of pupils and staff, to reflect the aspirations of the community, to support environmentally the efforts of the staff to provide a good education and to preserve the community's major investment.

In order to provide services that sufficiently support the educational program, the Board establishes as broad goals:

1. To provide a physical environment for teaching and learning that is safe and pleasant for pupils, staff and public;
2. To provide safe transportation for eligible pupils;
3. To make nutritious meals available to pupils; and
4. To provide resources, facilities and assistance to meet the needs of the educational program as they develop.
