### 8651 COMMUNITY USE OF TRANSPORTATION

New Jersey Administrative Code allows district boards of education to use school buses for other than to and from school and school-related activities. The Board may make school-owned vehicles available to transport groups of ten or more qualified senior or disabled citizens to civic, social, cultural, educational, recreational nutritional and health programs and activities within the district, or in the immediately surrounding districts. "Qualified" senior citizens are persons over sixty residing in the area served by this school district and their spouses of less than sixty if they are accompanying them.

The Board may also make district buses available to groups of children and adults participating in a recreation program provided by East Windsor Township or Hightstown Borough.

All requests for nonschool use of district buses shall be presented to the Board of Education for action. Requests for such bus use will only be considered if buses and drivers are available and the request can be accommodated without any disruption to the transportation services to district students.

The Superintendent shall formulate administrative regulations in conformity with N.J.A.C. 6A:27-7.8 and all other pertinent law. The regulations shall provide, among other things, for payment by the group of the costs incurred by the district in such use of its vehicles.
