COOPERATION WITH MUNICIPAL AGENCIES

9310 COOPERATION WITH MUNICIPAL AGENCIES

The Board of Education wishes to cooperate as fully as possible with other public entities in the community. The Superintendent will seek to develop positive working relationships with such entities, including but not limited to investigative committees, pooled resources, information exchange, and those acting as service advisors/providers.

In accordance with law, the district may accept or share the use of facilities or equipment with other local organizations. The terms of the acceptance or sharing will be decided for each instance and appropriate arrangements scheduled through the Community Education Office.

Police Authorities

It is the policy of the Board to cooperate with law enforcement agencies in the interest of the larger welfare of all citizens. At the same time, schools have the responsibility to parents/guardians/significant others for the welfare of their children while they are in school. To carry out this dual responsibility, the administration is directed to follow the procedures developed to implement Board policies.

Fire Department

The Superintendent will seek input from local fire officials on matters of fire safety and fire safety education. The fire department should be kept up to date on changes in the school buildings and class arrangements so that, in the event of an emergency, they will be prepared.
