### 9321 FINGERPRINTING PUPILS

The Board of Education will cooperate with a voluntary fingerprinting program for the protection of its pupils. This program will be carried out in cooperation with the county sheriff's office and local law enforcement officials in accordance with the requirements of law.

All pupils in grades kindergarten through nine will be eligible to participate with written authorization of their parent/guardian/significant other or temporary caretaker. Completed fingerprint cards will be given to the parent/guardian/significant other or temporary caretaker, and will not be retained by the school district or the law enforcement agency.

The Superintendent is directed to provide an orientation program for those pupils for whom fingerprinting has been authorized, and to develop appropriate administrative regulations for the implementation of the voluntary fingerprinting program in the district.
