## Senior Prom

**Two forms are attached to this letter. Both forms must be signed by a parent or guardian, even if you are 18 years old. In order to buy a Prom Ticket, you must hand in both forms with cash or a check (made out to HHS Class of 2019). Every person attending the prom must fill out these forms, even if the person does not attend HHS. If the person does not attend HHS, a photocopy of their ID must be attached to this packet.**

The cost for a prom ticket is **\$100.00 per person**.

Prom tickets can be purchased in the Counseling Office before school (7:15-8:30) or after school (2:10-2:45) **May 22 & 23rd and May 28th**. You must have the completed forms and payment with you in order to purchase prom tickets. If you are going with a "date," both sets of permission slips must be turned in together.

Students who are on the Loss of Privilege List may not attend. All school obligations must be cleared prior to paying for the Prom ticket. **Please get your form signed by a house office indicating that you do not have any outstanding obligations or loss of privileges before you purchase your prom ticket. If you lose your privileges after you purchase a prom ticket, you will not get a refund.**

You must sign up for a prom table on google classroom. There will be 10-12 people per table. Only one person per table is to fill out the table form. If you do not sign up for a table, you will be assigned to one .

The Prom will be held at **Hyatt Regency Princeton from 6:00-11:00 pm**. The address is 102 Carnegie Center Princeton, NJ 08540. (You will not be allowed to enter Prom after 6:30; please be on time.) Promenade will begin promptly at 4:00pm and end at 5:30pm.

All HHS students must be in school the day of the Prom and attend the Prom meeting.

Proper attire should be worn at all times at Prom. Girls are expected to wear formal wear. Sport coats are not acceptable. No baseball caps or sneakers are allowed. Smoking is not permitted inside or on the grounds of Hyatt Regency Princeton. Once you leave Prom, you may not return. Bring everything that you need/want (cameras, coats, money) inside with you, you will not be able to go back out to your car.

The Senior Prom is for Seniors of HHS in good standing and their guests. All students and their guests must be eligible to participate in extracurricular activities.

1. Selling prom tickets to someone else is forbidden.
2. **Students who have lost privileges will not be permitted to attend the prom.** This rule applies to students in all grades. If a student violates school policy during the prom, he/she will be held responsible and will face consequences on their return to school.
3. **If a student loses their privileges after they purchase a prom ticket, they will not receive a refund.**
4. Completed forms are required in order to purchase a prom ticket. No money will be accepted without signed forms. **All obligations must be cleared by the house office before tickets may be purchased.**
5. **Anyone attending the prom who is not a Hightstown High School student, must submit a copy of a photo ID when the tickets are purchased.**
6. A phone number where a parent or guardian can be reached in case of emergency must be on the form, even if you are 18 or older.
7. No alcoholic beverages are to be consumed by any student or guest at the Prom, regardless of age. Anyone found consuming, in possession of, or under the influence of an illegal substance, must leave the Prom. Per EWRSD Board of Education policy, all students attending this event are subject to testing with a breathalyzer throughout the evening. An administrator or a staff member will call the parent or guardian of any student or guest who is found to be under the influence. If a parent cannot be contacted within one hour, the student will be turned over to the police. The student(s) will also face **ALL** consequences as defined by the EWRSD Drug and Alcohol Policy, including but not limited to suspension or a hearing before the Board of Education for possible expulsion from school.
8. Students agree that once they leave the Prom, they may not return.
9. Students must arrive to Prom no later than 6:30 PM and may not leave before 10:30 PM.
10. This is a **SMOKE FREE** Prom. Smoking is not permitted inside or on the grounds of Hyatt Regency Princeton. This applies to both HHS Students and any guests. School rules regarding smoking apply and will be enforced.

**HIGHTSTOWN HIGH SCHOOL**  
**DANCES/PROMS PARENT PERMISSION FORM**

In an effort to increase social interaction for our students, Hightstown High School (“HHS”) plans to host several school sanctioned dances/proms this year. In order to keep our students safe from the dangers of alcohol, and in accordance with EWRSD Board Policy and New Jersey State law, HHS plans to screen some or all of the students attending these events for alcohol using a breathalyzer.

In order to be admitted/attend one of these HHS sanctioned dances/proms, students may be asked to talk into a small handheld device that senses alcohol on the breath. Should the student test positive using the **passive breathalyzer**, he/she will be re-tested in 20 minutes using an **active breathalyzer** requiring the students to blow into a tube. If the student tests positive again for the presence of alcohol, parent(s) will be called to escort the student to the hospital for a medical examination as per EWRSD Board Policy 5530. **Please Note: In the event that a parent(s) cannot be reached within one (1) hour the student will be turned over to the police.** In addition, students who test positive using the active breathalyzer or refuse to take a breathalyzer test will be subject to disciplinary action as per EWRSD Board Policy 5530.

Any student attending these HHS sponsored dances/proms may be required to take a breathalyzer test administered by a trained member of the staff or administrator prior to entering the event, during the course of the event, or upon leaving the event.

**ESCUELA SUPERIOR DE HIGHTSTOWN**  
**PLANILLA DE PERMISO PARA EL BAILE DE GRADUACION**

En un esfuerzo por mejorar la interacción social de nuestros estudiantes, la Escuela Superior de Hightstown (“HHS”) se propone clasificar algunos sancionados durante el baile de graduación de este año. Con el objetivo de mantener a nuestros estudiantes alejados del peligro del alcohol, y en concordancia con la política del Buró de Educación de EWRSD y la ley de Nueva Jersey, la escuela HHS planea detectar el uso del alcohol en algunos o en todos los estudiantes participantes, utilizando un analizador de respiración.

Para ser admitidos a participar en el baile de graduación HHS, puede que se les pida a algunos estudiantes sancionados por el uso de alcohol que hablen dentro de un pequeño dispositivo que detecta el alcohol en la respiración. Si los estudiantes examinados resultan positivos al utilizar el **analizador de respiración pasivo**, el/ella será reexaminado en 20 minutos utilizando un **analizador activo de respiración**, el cual requerirá que el estudiante sopla dentro de un tubo. Si el estudiante resulta positivo otra vez con presencia de alcohol, el/los padres será/serán llamados para llevar al estudiante al hospital, para un examen médico (según artículo 5530 del Buró de Educación de EWRSD). **Favor de notar: En caso de que el padre(s) no pueda ser localizado en dentro del plazo de una (1) hora el estudiante será entregado a la policía.** En adicción, los estudiantes que resulten positivos al utilizar el analizador activo de respiración, o que rechacen tomar el examen analizador de respiración, serán sujetos a una acción disciplinaria, según artículo 5530 del Buró de Educación de EWRSD.

Cualquier estudiante participante en el baile de graduación patrocinado por la escuela HHS, puede ser llamado a tomar el examen analizador de respiración (administrado por un miembro entrenado del personal administrativo), antes de entrar al evento, durante el curso del evento, o al marcharse del evento.
