Dear WCB Family,

We are looking forward to another great school year at WCB. As every new school year begins, we are happy to implement new initiatives. One initiative we are excited about was developed from Campaign Connect.

Campaign Connect is a school-wide stakeholder committee made up of parents, students, and staff that has been working with the Center for Supportive Schools for two years. Campaign Connect is a six step process. We are in step 5. Through data gathered from your surveys and focus groups, the committee identified areas of need at WCB. Over the summer, subcommittees met to restructure expectations and create lessons for students surrounding these three areas.

Campaign Connect identified unstructured time for students (cafeteria, recess, and hallway) as the most important needs for this school year.

The Following Objectives will be covered throughout the school year.

- Cafeteria - Expectations, Isolating peers, Tattling Vs. Telling
- Hallway - Walking as a Group, Walking individually/pairs
- Recess - Including others when playing games, Finding friends to play with, Tattling Vs. Telling

There will be changes to indoor and outdoor recess. During inclement weather we will have indoor recess. The students will have an opportunity to choose a structured activity on every A day. Students in kindergarten and first grade will be able to select different activities within designated classrooms. Second through fifth grade students will select their activity through an online sign-up sheet completed in homeroom (block one for grade five). During outdoor recess, there will be stations under teacher supervision that students can choose freely.

Sample Rooms	Description
Organized Game Room	Small group games and board games
Interactive Room	Dance activities through Go Noodle
Construction Club	Building with legos, K'nex, and other small materials
Craftivity Room	Arts and Crafts activities in the art room
Study Hall Room	Quiet learning activities and independent reading
Technology Room	Computer usage by students
Cinema Club	Relax and enjoy a movie
Get Fit Club	Sports activities in the gym
