Cafeteria Expectations

ATTENTION ALL DRIVERS:

If you're **buying lunch**, be sure to only drive on the **RIGHT** side of the road!

All drivers who are **NOT buying lunch**, make sure you **park your cars** right away!

Drivers: You will have the same parking spot ALL YEAR. Your parking spot can only be changed by Mrs. Felicetta, Mr. Tozzi, or Mr. Basmagy.

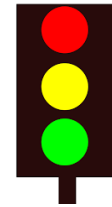


Be on the lookout for our Traffic Lights!!

If you see a **RED** cone, your lunch table needs to **be silent**.

If you see a **YELLOW** cone, your lunch table is getting too loud. **Time to whisper!**

If you see a **GREEN** cone, your lunch table is doing a **great job** with volume!



Don't forget to buckle up!!

Turning around in your parking spot can lead to a **RED** cone and traffic violations!

Expectations of the Road:

ALL drivers must follow traffic directions given by cafeteria monitors and teachers while driving in the cafeteria.

If your parking spot is assigned at tables 1, 2, 3, 4, 15, 16, 17, or 18 you must drive in the **left lane** to buy lunch and park.

If your parking spot is assigned at tables 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, or 14 you must drive in the **right lane** to buy lunch and park.

Drivers must remain buckled at all times!!
This means that your feet are on the floor and your bottom is in it's car seat, (bench).

Only 4 drivers are allowed to park in a row, (bench).

Drivers must be careful! Do not reverse!
Turning your car to talk to friends behind you could lead to a crash! Stay in your parking spot the WHOLE time.



Drivers must always use their signals!
If a driver needs to use the bathroom, please use sign language. All other driver needs can be met by a hand raise!

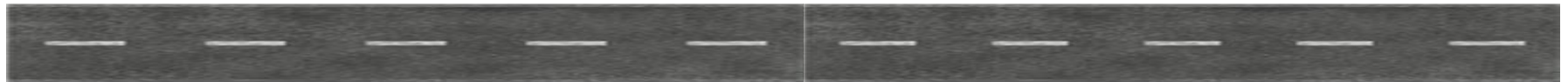
Leaving your parking spot...



ALL drivers will be greeted by a cafeteria monitor with large trash cans. ALL drivers must throw out trash from their parking spots, (tables) ONLY.

Once a table is clean, drivers may slowly drive, (walk) to the exit of the cafeteria. Drivers will then wait for the teacher in the cafeteria to tell them their driving directions.

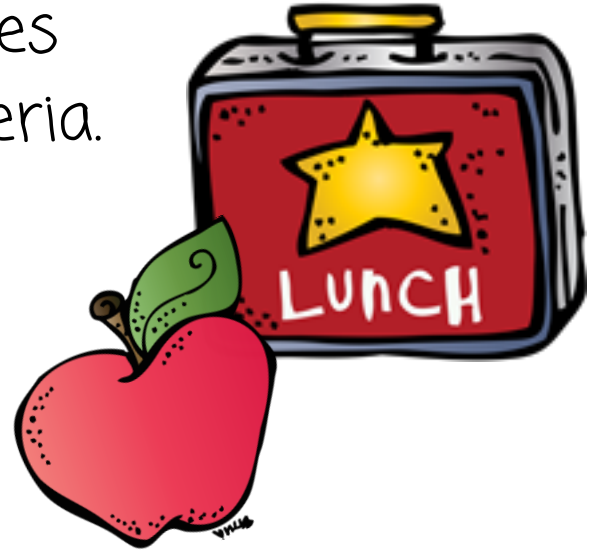
Drivers need to be careful when exiting the cafeteria! It's important to listen carefully and to follow driving directions, so all can move safely on the roads!
